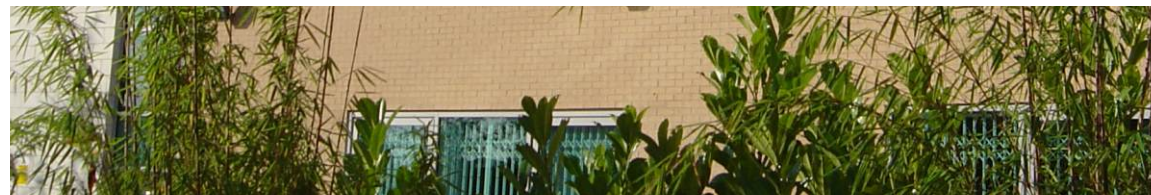

How to find us:

BY AIR

The nearest airport is Leeds Bradford, which is around 40-50 mins drive from York. There are cars available to hire at the airport.

BY TRAIN

York is on the main East Coast Line from London Kings Cross to Edinburgh. Fast train services leave from both north and south at frequent intervals. There is also a direct service across the Pennines between York, Leeds and Manchester Airport. The science park is 2 miles from the railway station so you would need to get a bus or taxi from the station. (From the station it is a 15 min journey by taxi.)

BY CAR

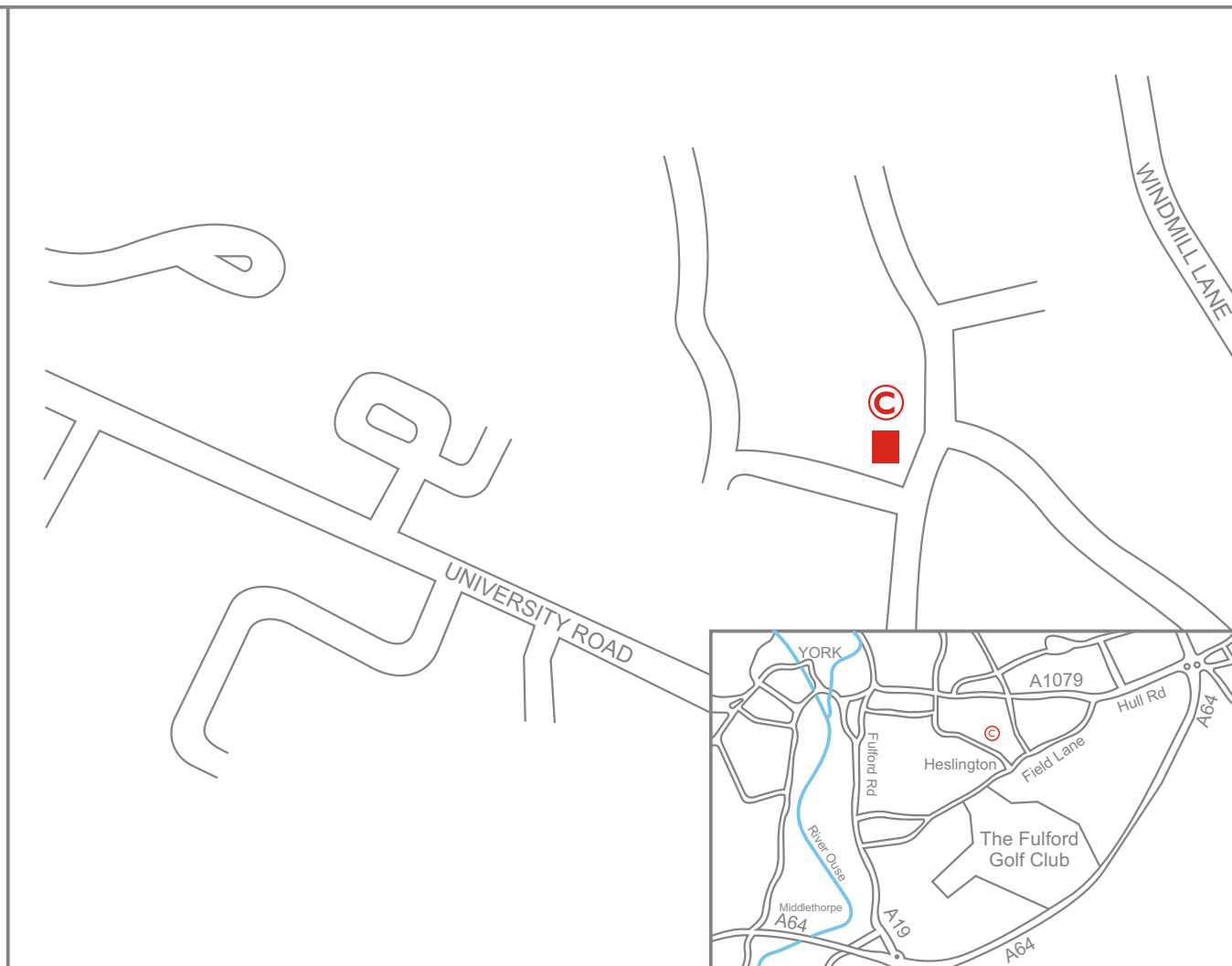
If you are travelling to York by car via the A64 then you should turn off at one of the exits marked University/Science Park (A19/A1079), in order to avoid the City centre. Subsequent turns are signposted.

Visitors approaching from other directions should either

- Take the Selby Road (A19) to Fulford and turn along Heslington Lane, or Broadway towards Heslington.
- Take the Hull Road and turn right at the first traffic lights into Green Dykes Lane which leads to University Road.

BY BUS

You can reach York by coach from many destinations around the country. A number of bus companies operate buses, which have stops close to the Science Park: Nos. 4 and 24 depart from the railway station. Journey time is around 20 min. Other services are the T27, Y28, C2 and 64A. The main bus station is at Rougier Street.
